



RESOLUTION NO. xxx-2020

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 23, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$236,677,811 computed as follows:

2020-2021 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 3.73% or the factor of 1.0373;  
2020-2021 Increase in Population is 1.70% or the factor of 1.0170;  
1.0373 (X) 1.0170 = 1.0549 is the combined factor for increasing the 2019-2020 appropriation limitation.

Growth Factor FY 2020-2021:	<u>1.0549</u>
Limit for FY 2020-2021:	\$236,677,811
