**Subject: Supplemental Staff Report regarding the Consideration of the Bid protest letter received from Yubacon, Inc. and proceedings thereon regarding the Union Mine Disposal Site Final Cover bid.**

**Recommendation:**

On September 12, 2006 staff submitted its report to the Board regarding the Consideration of the Bid protest letter received from Yubacon, Inc and proceedings thereon regarding the Union Mine Disposal Site Final Cover bid. Upon review of the Staff report it was discovered that in discussing the Board actions that could be taken, the following corrections should be made:

Upon hearing the presentations of the parties, the Board may choose one of the following options:

1. Take no action. This would result in no change to the prior award to Veerkamp.
2. Move for reconsideration of the bid award. If the motion is successful, the Board would consider the facts in light of the bid protest submitted by Yubacon and make a new determination on the award of the bid.

If the Board reconsiders the bid award, then the Board may take the following actions:

- Reject all bids and order the project re-bid;
- Consider all facts regarding the bids and do one of the following:
  1. Find that the irregularities in the Yubacon bid are material and make the award to Veerkamp;
  2. Find that the irregularities in the Yubacon bid are not material, waive the irregularities, and award the bid to Yubacon; or,
  3. Find that the irregularities in the Yubacon bid are not material, but nevertheless decline to waive the irregularities and award the bid to Veerkamp.
