Resolution for Road Closure for "Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration"

WHEREAS, The Garden Valley Community Association (sponsor) desires to hold the "Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration" in Garden Valley on Sunday, July 4, 2010, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., sanctioning the road closure of Marshall Road between Garden Valley Road and Greenwood Road in Garden Valley, El Dorado County, and;

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the "Garden Valley Annual 4th of July Parade and Celebration" on Sunday, July 4, 2010; and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Marshall Road between Garden Vally Road and Greenwood Road from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 4th, 2010, subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the Application for Road Closure submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
