Subject: **Fee Waiver Request – Props, Cops, and Rodders Temporary Use Permit**

The California Highway Patrol Senior Volunteers in cooperation with the El Dorado Community Foundation, a local 501(c)3 non-profit organization, has requested a fee waiver in the amount of \$1,303 for the Temporary Use Permit (TUP) Fees related to hosting a Car Show fundraiser with proceeds benefiting the local community.

This fundraising event is scheduled for September 30, at the Cameron Park Airpark located at 3374 Mira Loma Drive in Cameron Park, with one hundred percent (100%) of the event's profit going to various community non-profit organizations. Due to the nature of this event and the planned activities, a TUP is required.

Pursuant to Board of Supervisors Policy B-2, section II, B(3), the Department is recommending that the request for the fee waiver associated with this event as the proceeds from the event will provide a substantial public benefit. Over the past several years, this event has raised over \$20,000 for non-profit organizations including The Upper Room, Boys and Girls Club, New Beginnings, Court Appointed Child Advocates (CASA), and the Ponderosa High School Band.

The TUP fees in the amount of \$1,303 include \$496 for Planning fees, \$86 for Environmental Management fees, and \$721 for DOT fees (see page 5 of the attached Community Development Combined Fees). As such, the Department is recommending the Chief Administrative Office forward this request to the Board of Supervisors for consideration to waive the full amount of the TUP fees.
