## Artist Bio

Linda George, retired, lives in Placerville where she grows tomatoes, raises chickens and designs fabric wall art. “I’ve been sewing since I was seven years old, but never as a quilter...just the thought of the precise little squares of fabric and a 2–3 month project kept me away from quilting as I knew it. I made my first free–form art quilt for Threads of Life, a quilt auction to benefit Marshall Cancer Resource Center, and I’ve never looked back.”

Linda favors free–motion quilting because “there are no rules”. She uses nature as her subjects, and has ventured into abstract designs using paints and other

embellishments such as beads and has worked on commissioned pieces as well. She comes from a family of artists and art teachers and finds this medium very satisfying. She donates many of her quilts to local charitable organizations for use in their fundraising.

Her works have won ribbons in the art quilt category at the El Dorado County Fair. She displays at various locations in downtown. One of her quilts was chosen to hang in the new wing at Marshall Hospital. In 2014 she was honored to show at the Pacific International Quilt Festival in Santa Clara. She is a member of the El Dorado Arts Council.

Four of her quilts were chosen to represent California State Parks for their 150th Anniversary in 2014.
