Resolution for Road Closure for the "Sugarloaf Stampede Run"

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Office of Education desires to hold the Sugarloaf Stampede Fundraising Run on Saturday, March 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the "Sugarloaf Stampede Run" on Saturday, March 29, 2014; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Jacquier Road, Smith Flat Road and Smith Flat School Road. Additionally El Dorado County Explorers and CHP Officer Advisors will provide crossing gaurds for each major cross street. This event is scheduled for Saturday, March 29, 2014 from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., for the "Sugarloaf Stampede Run," subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110.79 dated May 1, 1979, and condtions set forth in the Application for Road Closure submitted for this event.


This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
