### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 5135

This ordinance hereby amends the El Dorado County Ordinance Code Title 5- Business Taxes, Licenses and Regulations - Chapter 5.56.- Vacation Home Rentals with amendments to include clarifying updates to the code for the purpose of program implementation and introducing a cap of 900 permits total in the Tahoe Basin. Adoption of this ordinance will be heard by the Board of Supervisors on December 2, 2020. The Public Hearing shall be held virtually.
