Adopt-A-Trail volunteers cover 16 segments of the trail


Maintenance is performed by County staff and volunteers

# Adopt-A-Trail

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- AAT – Relaunched in 2025
- 16 Segments from Francis Cow Camp to Rubicon Springs
- Adoptees are OHV Clubs, Non-Profits and Fabricators
- Sediment Removal – 236 Buckets = 5.841 Cubic Yards
