



**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_**  
**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California, by enactment of the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 ("AB 939"), has declared that it is within the public interest to authorize and require local agencies to make adequate provisions for solid waste handling within their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2008 the Board of Supervisors gave direction to the Environmental Management Department to research and bring back to the Board a status report and recommendation regarding the feasibility of increasing residential (curbside) recycling through a programmatic approach by franchise area, including multiple cart service programs and bluebag programs, that could be implemented in the hard to service areas; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Management Department met with the service provider Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Company to discuss options and service levels within the unincorporated area of El Dorado County in the service provider's franchise area as defined in Exhibit A, Franchise Area Description, in the Collection Franchise Agreement between El Dorado County and Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Company, dated April 4, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Management Department is recommending further promotion of the existing curbside blue bag recycling program and addition of a seasonal free green waste collection event within the Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Company franchise area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, let it be resolved by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors effective after January 1, 2009 but no later than March 1, 2009, the public education materials promoting the seasonal green waste collection event and the continued use of blue bags for the collection of recyclables within Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Company franchise area will be produced and approved by the Environmental Management Department, and will be distributed by Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal to all residential customers on or about Earth Day, 2009.
