**Resolution for Road Closure for the 2016
“Georgetown Divide Founder’s Day Event”**

WHEREAS, The Georgetown Divide Rotary Club (Sponsor) desires to hold the “Georgetown Divide Founder’s Day Event” on Sunday, September 18, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said Sponsor has requested a road closure “Special Event Permit” pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Georgetown Divide Founder’s Day Event” on Sunday, September 18, 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that road closures will be in effect for Main Street in Georgetown between Highway 193 and School Street. Additionally, road barricades will be located at the intersections of Main Street/Placer Street, Main Street/Orleans Street and Main Street/Harkness Street between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18, 2016, for the “Georgetown Divide Founder’s Day Event,” subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79.

This Resolution and the “Special Event Application” with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the road closure “Special Event Permit”.


