March 15-21st is National Sunshine Week – Open Government Is Good Government. Though created by journalists, Sunshine Week is about the public's right to know what its government is doing, and why. Participants include news media, civic groups, libraries, nonprofits, schools and others interested in the public's right to know. The Sunshine Week initiative is increasing public awareness, it's coming up more often in policy conversations, and the efforts of participants are being cited as real forces for moving the public away from simply accepting excessive and unwarranted government secrecy.

My purpose today is to present another couple of CPRAs. As this Board is aware, we were having regular meetings with Norma Santiago during 2014 concerning timely and appropriate responses to CPRAs. **Compass2Truth** has focused particularly on tackling issues regarding the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge, the Coloma Resort, the American River Conservancy, and the Sheriff's Office. Most of those meetings were a waste of valuable time and effort since Norma failed to follow up on specific issues that disappeared into the mysterious "black hole" known as political Bureaucratic Shenanigans.

Subsequently we met on 11/12/14 with Robyn Drivon and Paula Franz, but the issues on (this) prepared agenda were also obtusely diverted. Not surprisingly, we've also been having the same problems with Rory Allen, legal counsel for CA State Parks. This does not bode well for government transparency and accountability.

At this time I'd like to take this opportunity to commend Larry Weitzman for his investigative journalism. Kudos as well to organizations like Save Our County, RIPP, Shingle Springs Community Alliance and many other conscientious individuals who have the persistence necessary to attend meetings, hold our civil servant's feet to the fire, ensure they uphold their oaths of office and take seriously their fiduciary obligations to the citizens of this county.

On Wednesday, January 28th at 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM a public meeting will be held at the Coloma Grange Hall regarding the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge. I'd like to draw your attention to the December 12th email that was just distributed to you and the issues that remain unaddressed, specifically the DECEPTION buried in this CIP project within Supervisor Ranalli's district.

It is imperative that you know the FACTS prior to making any further decisions that will affect all future CIP bridge projects throughout EDC. CH2M Hill, Matt Smeltzer and Janet Postlewait have presented a lot of inaccurate and blatantly false information to the BOS in order to arrive at a predetermined outcome under the guise of "public input and participation." The evidence is indisputably witnessed and audio recorded by

multiple individuals. Since you have been made aware of malfeasance, you are therefore responsible for taking corrective action.

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act, I ask to obtain the following concerning the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge CIP (read bullet excerpts.)

Additionally I submit yet another CPRA concerning copies of the **CURRENT** CSAC Excess Insurance Authority and Crime Insurance Policies.

Supervisor Ranalli, I trust that you will be much more cooperative than Ron Briggs was in meeting with us to address constituent concerns. I anticipate a follow up phone call from Brenda Bailey to schedule an appointment to discuss concerns affecting the entirety of El Dorado County.

Mr./Madam Clerk: Please enter these CPRAs into the public record and note you have 10 days in which to reply.

One SAC member commented that the meeting summary from previous SAC meetings contained errors and the County has not corrected the documents. **FALSE!! MULTIPLE SAC MEMBERS MADE COMMENTS BUT WERE CENSORED!!** Matt said that all comments on the meeting summaries were reviewed and a need for corrections was not identified. **FALSE!!!** Meeting summaries are not intended to provide verbatim minutes to the meetings. **THAT WAS NOT THE INTENT!!!**

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.), I ask to obtain the following concerning the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge CIP:

- CDA/DOT's copy of the Caltrans inspection report conducted July 15, 2014 which deemed the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge "functionally obsolete and structurally deficient."
- The identity of County staff responsible for the following biased decisions and false statements. Please include all relevant correspondence including handwritten notes and emails, and an explanation why I was not contacted prior to the public posting of the September 24th SAC Summary on the EDC website:


