

Proclamation

of the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors Recognizing the Grand Opening of Marshal Medical Center's New Patient Wing

WHEREAS, Marshall Hospital is celebrating the opening of a new patient care wing; and

WHEREAS, this new 88,000 square feet "South Wing" will house a state-of-the-art facility including a much needed new Emergency Department/Level III Trauma Center and a new Birth Center; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 1957, Michigan-California Lumber Company donated the first \$100,000 of community funds, as well as the land; and old pear orchard, upon which to build the new hospital; and

WHEREAS, Marshall Hospital opened its doors to the public on July 1, 1959, with 49 patient beds and 12 physicians on staff; and

WHEREAS, in the years between 1975 to 1982 various expansions to the hospital were added including a new Diagnostic Care Facility, an 8-bed Intensive Care/Critical Care Unit, an 84-bed patient wing, lobby and waiting area and 80% of the facility was remodeled; and

WHEREAS, in the years since 1988 new facilities have opened in Cameron Park, Georgetown, Placerville and El Dorado Hills; and

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has continued to be an independent, non-profit hospital and community healthcare provider and its mission remains to provide health services of extraordinary value and quality to our community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors congratulates Marshall Medical Center on their Grand Opening and Open House including a ribbon cutting scheduled for Thursday, September 13, 2012.
