I am writing to express our opposition to the above listed annexation. As you know, CSA#7 was approved by the voters for the specific purpose of funding advanced life support (ALS) ambulance services on the west slope of the county. If this annexation is allowed to occur as proposed, CSA#7 tax shares intended for public safety will be redirected to the El Dorado Irrigation District. This shift in tax shares is not necessary since EID is an enterprise agency with the ability to fund new development projects through the application of fees and rates. Public safety agencies have been greatly impacted by the economic crisis and it is essential that we protect the limited funding sources we have.
