

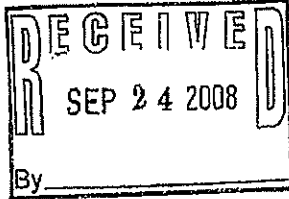

Dear Mindy:

I would first like to thank you for arranging to meet with us regarding the possible opportunity to receive one of your small buses for the Sheriff's Department. As follow-up to our discussions I am sending this letter to you, in an attempt to have the Board of Directors review the possibility of donating an out of service bus to the Sheriff's Department-Transportation Division.

As discussed during the meeting our reasoning for this request is simple. We don't currently have a vehicle that is A.D.A. compliant. With the receipt of one of your buses it will simplify the transportation of inmates with disabilities to and from court as well as to the prisons. A second justification is that we currently don't have a vehicle that will allow us to transport more than 10 individuals to the prisons at one time. With the overpopulations at the prisons they are requiring us to hold inmates awaiting prison sentences for sometimes two to three weeks. This wait requires us to have to take two vans down and four Deputies. With the receipt of the bus, this should allow us to only take one vehicle and two Deputies to make this transport.

Any assistance you could provide our department would be greatly appreciated. If I can be of any assistance in this process, let me know.
