AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING <u>UPDATES TO THE COUNTY ASSESSMENT APPEALS</u>
BOARD ORDINANCE UPDATING THE COUNTY BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND
COMMISSIONS — COUNTY ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD

## THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.20.060 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code "Qualifications" is hereby amended as follows:

## 2.20.060 - Qualifications:

- A. A person shall be eligible for nomination for membership only if he or she has a minimum of five years' professional experience in the State as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant, licensed real estate broker, attorney, property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization or is a person who the nominating member of the Board of Supervisors has reason to believe is possessed of competent knowledge of property appraisal and taxation or as otherwise provided by law. A person shall be eligible for membership only if they meets the requirements in Revenue and Taxation Code section 1624, as it now reads or may thereafter be amended.
- B. New members of the Assessment Appeals Board are encouraged to complete a training course conducted by the State Board of Equalization as soon as is reasonably possible within one year of taking office.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days following adoption hereof.
