CalWORKs Community Service/Work Experience Boilerplate Agreements

**WHEREAS**, the Health and Human Services Agency, on behalf of the County of El Dorado, determines participant eligibility for the statewide California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Welfare-to-Work Program is the employment and training aspect of CalWORKs, which provides CalWORKs participants with a comprehensive array of services designed to enhance CalWORKs participant employability; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Service/Work Experience is a CalWORKs service designed to provide CalWORKs participants with the opportunity to gain unpaid training and work experience, to enhance their employability in the open job market; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health and Human Services Agency, working with County Counsel and Risk Management, has developed the attached "CalWORKs Community Service/Work Experience Program Worksite Agreement" boilerplate; and


**WHEREAS**, the boilerplate agreement defines the roles and responsibilities of the County, the CalWORKs participant, and the private sector entity providing the community service/work experience training to the CalWORKs participant.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado hereby authorizes the Director of the Health and Human Services Agency, or designee, to execute future Community Service/Work Experience Program boilerplate agreements using the "CalWORKs Community Service/Work Experience Program Worksite Agreement" boilerplate attached hereto as Exhibit A.
