



RESOLUTION NO. 096-2014

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY,
TRANSPORTATION DIVISION TO CLAIM AN ALLOCATION OF
\$62,400 IN TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
PROJECTS FROM THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION
COMMISSION FOR THE EL DORADO TRAIL FROM
LOS TRAMPAS DRIVE TO HALCON ROAD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 10/11.03-A, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) allocated \$62,400 of Local Transportation Fund (LTF) for Bicycle and Pedestrian projects to the El Dorado County Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2012 the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors created the Community Development Agency by combining the Development Services Department, Environmental Management Department and the Department of Transportation. The El Dorado County Department of Transportation is now referred to as the Community Development Agency, Transportation Division; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Agency, Transportation Division intends to use its EDCTC funding to match the \$457,979 FY 2010/11 Recreational Trails Program grant to design and construct the El Dorado Trail from Los Trampas Drive to Halcon Road, CIP Project No. 97012.


