



RESOLUTION NO. 071-2014
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 17, 2014;

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$176,226,269 computed as follows:

2014-2015 Increase in the California per capita personal income is -0.23% or the factor of 0.9977;
2014-2015 Increase in Population is 0.21% or the factor of 1.0021;
 $0.9977 (X) 1.0021 = 0.9998$ is the combined factor for increasing the 2013-2014 appropriation limitation.

Limit for FY2014-2015:	\$176,226,269
