RE: Notice of Termination of Revenue Recovery MOU

Dear Mr. Semon:

This letter is to inform you of the Court's intention to terminate the agreement between the Superior Court of California and the Revenue Recovery Division of El Dorado County Department of Child Support Services, memorialized in writing by Agreement 492-M1511, effective July 1, 2017. This termination is in accordance with sections 4.2 and 6.5 of the current MOU, which state in relevant part:

- 4.2 Termination. Either Party may terminate this Memorandum by giving notice to the other Party in the manner specified in Section 6.5 below; provided, however, such termination shall not be effective, and this Memorandum shall remain in full force and effect, unless and until County and Court execute a written memorandum setting forth their agreement on the operation of a subsequent comprehensive collection program as required by Penal Code Section 1463.010. Such notice shall be given at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of County's fiscal year and, subject to satisfying the requirements of this section 4.2, shall become effective only upon the first day of the succeeding fiscal year of County.

Any notices required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and may (a) be personally delivered; (b) be mailed by depositing such notice in the United States mail, first class postage prepaid; or (c) be sent by reputable overnight delivery service; addressed as follows or to such other place as each Party may designate by subsequent written notice to the other Party:
