The essence of the following objectives have been noted for simplicity and to identify the issues CEDAC believes are especially important.

- Objective 2.3 Identify and implement best practices in departments serving the public, continue striving to improve customer support, and improve communications with the public.
- Objective 2.4 (in many ways repeats the same things as the previous objective): Develop service level standards for all line/constituent facing departments for the purpose of continuous service improvements as well as establishing a framework for improved communications and customer engagement.
- Objective 2.5: Recognize and develop both internal and external processes to effectively inform County employees, the public, and communication channels about changes in county regulations and local newsworthy events.

The committee looks forward to offering our support in attaining these stated objectives. One possible way would be working with a new Communications and Outreach Manager. An

existing position that can attain some of the objectives is the Development Services Division Customer Service Ombudsman. To be effective, though, the public should be aware of this important support position. Communication about County services should be part of the ultimate goal.
