A goal for reducing the number of criminal <b>property damage</b> reports.
A goal to increase the percent of residents <b>who feel</b> their community is a safe place to live and work.
Incidents of Abuse Goals
A goal to reduce the number of incidents of abuse (domestic, child, and elder abuse)
A goal to increase the number of cases prosecuted.
Incidents of Discrimination Goals
A goal for reducing the number of reports regarding employment discrimination and housing discrimination.
