The purpose of this letter is to inform the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that El Dorado County intends to receive to the Transition Grant (FFTA) funding for 2021 through 2025.

By choosing to participate in the Transition Grant funding El Dorado County understands they will receive funding through FFTA federal grant to start or continue performing activities related to FFPSA as outlined in All County Letter 21-47. As a condition of receiving the Transition Grant funding, the county commits to submitting data obtained through related prevention planning activities to the CDSS in order to enhance statewide planning efforts.
