



## RESOLUTION NO.

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**Resolution to Authorize the Community Development Agency Director to Temporarily Close a Section of Alder Drive between Pony Express Trail and Cedar Drive for the Construction of the Alder Drive at EID Canal - Bridge Replacement Project During the 2016 Construction Season**

**WHEREAS**, the County plans to replace the Alder Drive Bridge with two (2) thirty (30) inch diameter culverts and construct other roadway improvements on Alder Drive for Capital Improvement Project No. 77123 during the 2016 construction season; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to construct the roadway improvements, Alder Drive, between Pony Express Trail and Cedar Drive, will need to be closed for no more than eighty-five (85) consecutive days; and

**WHEREAS**, an alternate access route/detour will be available during the temporary closure and traffic will be directed by signage to this route/detour; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e), the Board of Supervisors is authorized to temporarily close a portion of any street for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e) and California Streets and Highways Code Section 942.6, the Board of Supervisors may delegate the powers associated with road closures to the County Road Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of El Dorado Ordinance Title 12, titled Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places, Chapter 12.04 Administration, Section 12.04.030 Road Commissioner Defined, defines Road Commissioner as Director of the Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2.14 of the County of El Dorado Code of Ordinance states that any references in the code to the Community Development Director, Development Services Director, Environmental Management Director, the Director of Public Works, or the Director of Transportation shall be understood to refer to the Community Development Agency Director or his/her qualified designated representative;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Community Development Agency Director is authorized to order the temporary closure of Alder Drive, between Pony Express Trail and Cedar Drive, for up to eighty-five (85) consecutive days and to establish an alternate access route for traffic use during the time of temporary closure. The precise dates of the temporary road closure are to be determined by the Community Development Agency Director, with notification of the pending temporary road closure and alternate route to be provided to the County Supervisors, business owners, residents, the general public, the El Dorado County Transit Authority and to safety and law enforcement agencies in the Project area, through direct communications, signage, or flyers.
