



RESOLUTION NO. 128-2015

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the Deputy Sheriffs' Association have met and negotiated in good faith since October 30, 2013, and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of economic cost savings and cost neutral issues in recognition of the tough economic issues facing the County to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016, and

WHEREAS, members of the Deputy Sheriffs' Association have held elections and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding, and

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the Deputy Sheriffs' Association, expired December 31, 2013, and the County representatives are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated hereinto the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado direct Human Resources Department and the Auditor/Controller's Office to implement changes to the provisions of the successor Deputy Sheriffs' Association Memorandum of Understanding to be effective the first full pay period following Board adoption of this Resolution by the Board of Supervisors.
