



PROCLAMATION

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO TO CELEBRATE MARSHALL MEDICAL CENTER'S 60TH ANNIVERSARY OF PROVIDING AWARD-WINNING HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, Marshall Hospital Center opened its doors in 1959, originally as a 49-bed facility; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has grown to a 125-bed acute care facility with 18 clinic sites around the Western Slope of El Dorado County and has become a significant economic driver in the County; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center is locally governed by a volunteer Board of Directors who maintain Marshall Medical's financial stability and oversee strategy and growth; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center is one of the largest employers in the County with 1800 employees; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has received numerous designations and awards for patient care; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center is staying true to its mission of remaining an independent hospital, transforming healthcare in El Dorado County through compassion, quality and innovation; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center marks its 60th anniversary in July 2019.
