## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at 9 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible on Tuesday, May 21, 2024, to consider the annual update to the Traffic Impact Fee (TIF) Program fee schedule. General Plan Measure TC-B requires the County to adopt a traffic impact fee program and to update the program annually for changes in project costs; and County Ordinance No. 5173 provides that said fees shall be adjusted annually by an increase or decrease in actual projects costs or pursuant to the Engineering News Record – Construction Cost Index. Project costs have been updated as required by Ordinance No. 5173, resulting in revisions to the TIF Program schedule as shown below.

The Board of Supervisors meeting room will be open to the public, unless otherwise indicated on the published agenda. The meeting will be livestreamed via Zoom and YouTube. Members of the public may address the Board in-person or via Zoom to make a public comment. All person interested should refer to the published agenda to obtain remote meeting ID and instructions.
