



**RESOLUTION NO. 036-2024**

**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1, the Behavioral Health Services Program and Bond Measure, is on the March 5, 2024 Statewide Ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 would issue \$6.38 billion in bonds alongside statutory changes to the Mental Health Services Act; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 would erode local control and take away the rights of local governments to have separate zoning for substance use disorder facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 will shift an additional five percent of El Dorado County's Mental Health Service Act tax dollars to the state; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 reduces flexibility and mandates how counties utilize Mental Health Services Act funds for community-based services; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 provides no additional operational funding for substance use disorder facilities and housing facilities allowed by the bond; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1 allows the State to issue directives and sanctions if the County is determined to not be meeting the needs of clients and or the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors, County of El Dorado, State of California, that the Board of Supervisors stands for local control and the flexibility to service community needs with community-based solutions and opposes Proposition 1.
