**WHEREAS**, equality of opportunity and freedom from discrimination are fundamental to supporting joy, personal fulfillment and economic success; and

**WHEREAS**, El Dorado County celebrates the American values of liberty, equality, freedom of expression and the pursuit of happiness and recognizes the importance of its residents, visitors and employees to safely express their multifaceted identities which enrich our communities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize June 2022, as LGBTQIA+ Pride Month and honors all efforts that provide opportunities for a life free from discrimination and prejudice and in support of equality and the pursuit of happiness.
