Parks and Trails Map by Districts



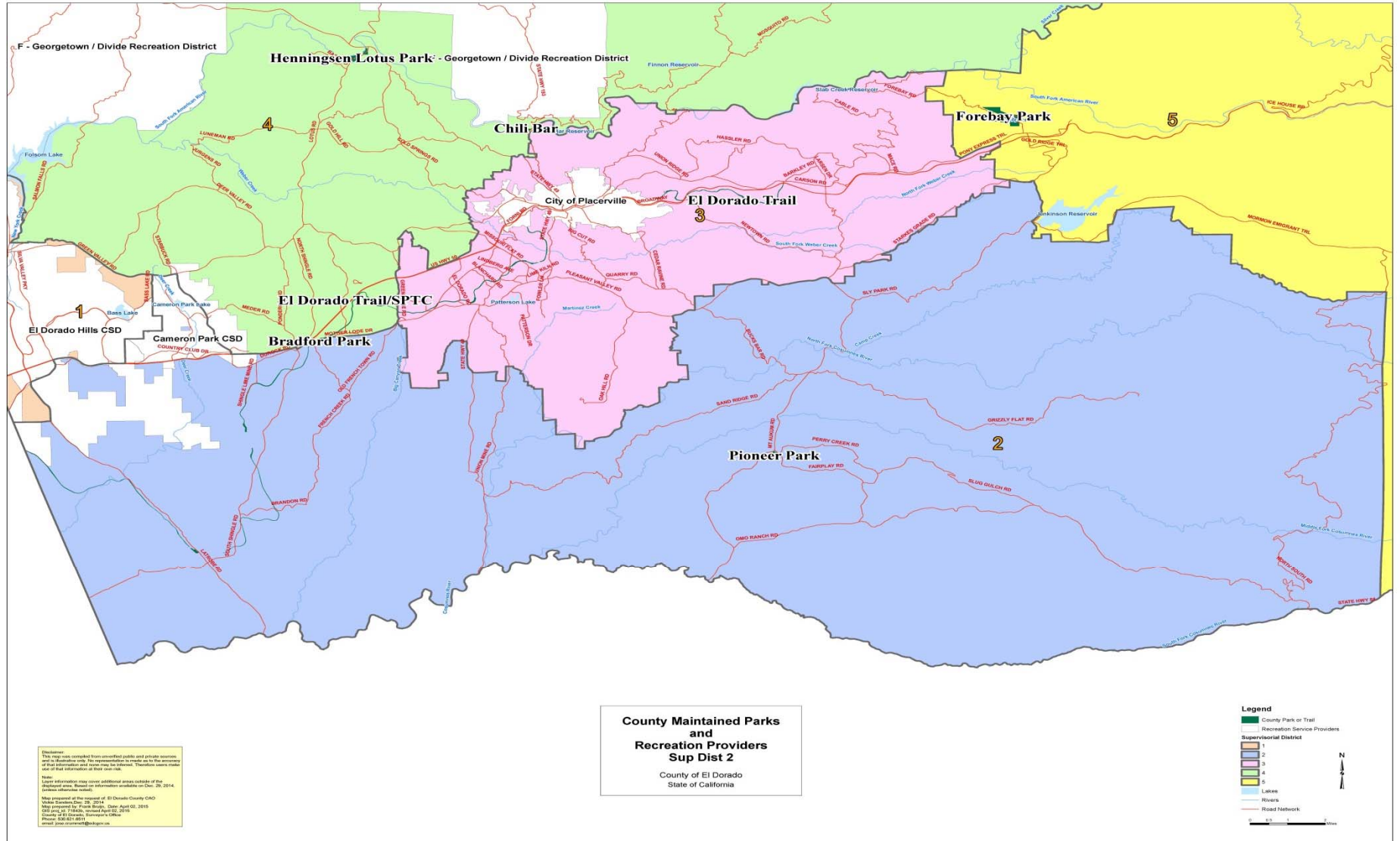
District I

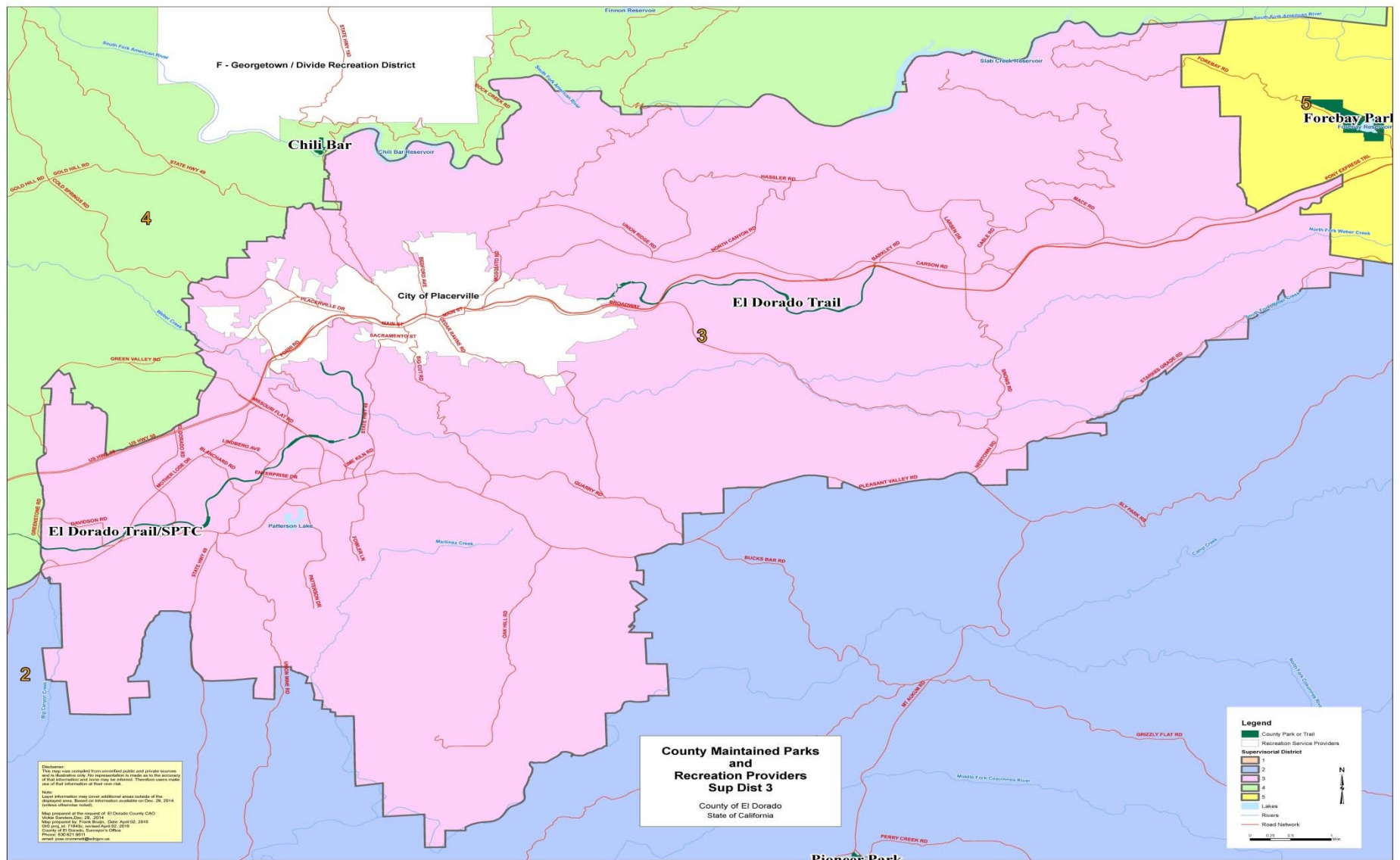

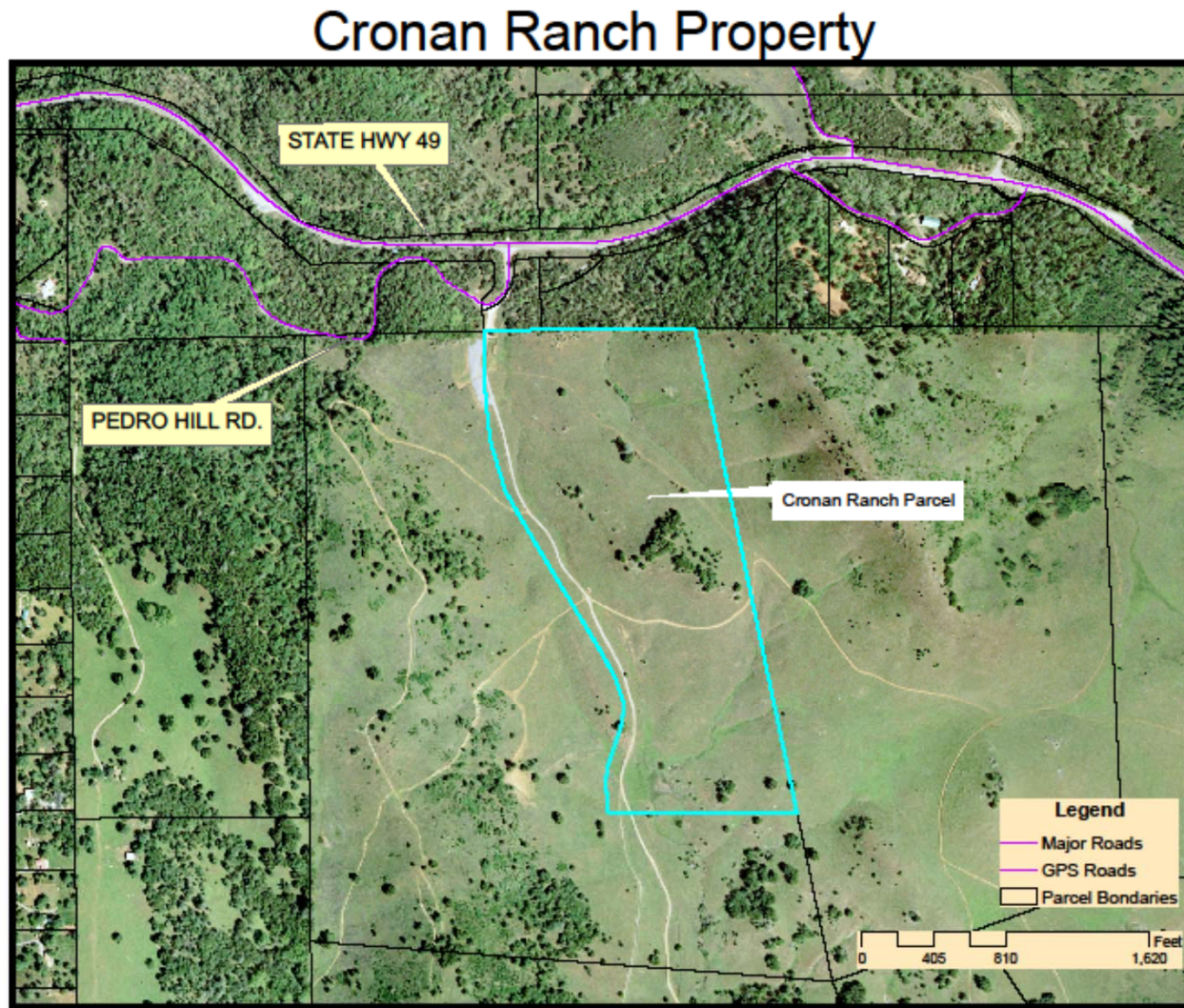

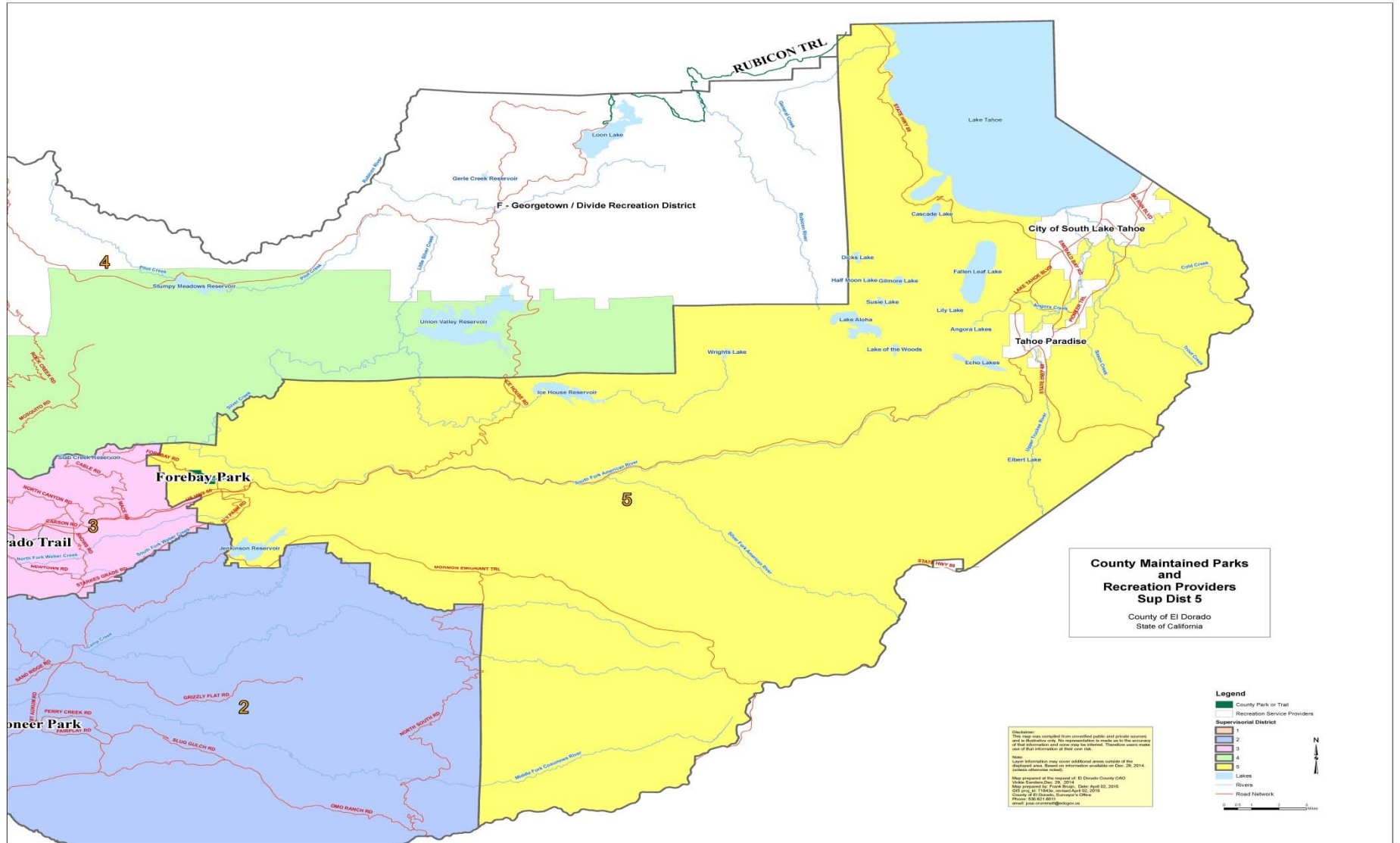
