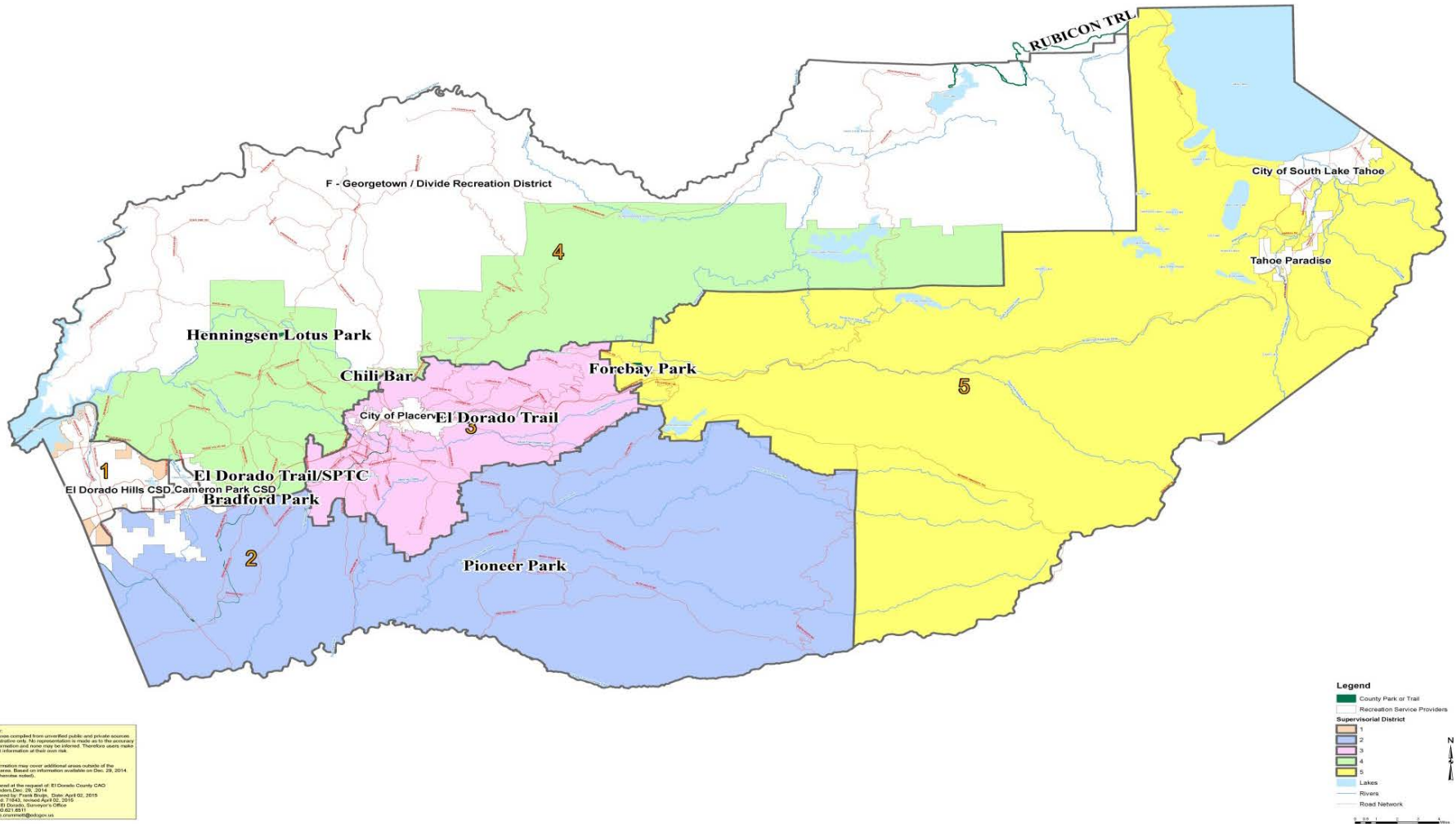

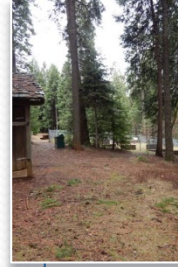

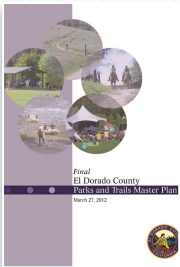
Old Depot Road Bike Park

- Est. Completion: Environmental-Summer 2022, Restroom-Fall 2022



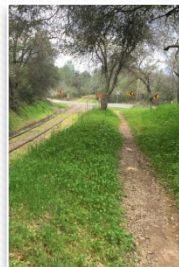

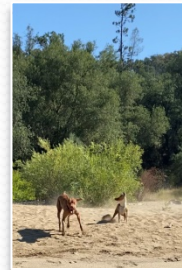
