NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO._____
THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. Chapter 9.55 of Title 9 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code is hereby added as follows: CHAPTER 9.55

PROHIBITION OF REGISTERED SEX OFFENDERS FROM ENTERING COUNTY PARKS, SCHOOLS, AND OTHER AREAS WHERE CHILDREN CONGREGATE.

.010 Purpose.
Sex offenders pose a clear threat to the children residing or visiting in the community. Further, there are no guarantees that they will not re-offend. Convicted sex offenders are more ilkely than any other type of offender to re-offend for another sexual as-

B. it is anticipated that the County of Ei Dorado will be chosen as a location for the placement of numerous sexual offenders on their release from incarcera-tion, and without an ordinance such as this, children in Ei Dorado County may unnecessarily be put at in-

C. In order to reduce the potential risk of harm to children in Ei Dorado County, there is a need to limit the opportunity for sex offenders to be in contact with unsuspecting children in locations that are primarily designed for use by, or are primarily used by chif-dren, including, but not limited to: the grounds of public or private schools for children, school bus stops, centers or facilities that provide day care or children's services, video arcades, public and private playgrounds and piay facilities, parks, youth sports facilities, skate parks, libraries, and public swimming poois.

D. Currently, state law does not adequately address the areas that sex offenders can frequent. Instead, state law only regulates where sex offenders can reside in relation to a limited number of specified areas. This ordinance is not intended to conflict with, but to supplement, state law by imposing restrictions on the locations which sex offenders may frequent in Ei Dorado County in order to ensure the safety of

For these reasons, the board of supervisors of Ei Dorado County finds that a public emergency exists that affects the life, health and public welfare of children, residents in, and visitors to, the County of Ei Dorado, and that the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety require the adoption of this

Definitions.

A. "Children": For purposes of this ordinance, children means those persons who are under the age of

eighteen (18) years.

B. "Registered sex offender": For purposes of this ordinance, sex offender means an individual who is

ordinance, sex offender means an individual who is registered, or required to register, by any state or rederal agency as a sex offender and/or whose name is published or required to be published on any state or federal sex offender registry, including, but not limited to any person required to register pursuant to California Penal Code sections 290, et seq.

C. "Park": For purposes of this ordinance, a park is defined as any park located in El Dorado County, before or after the effective date of this article, including, but not limited to, tot-lots, play areas, play grounds, river recreation areas, picnic areas, youth sports facilities, community centers, public swimming pools, skate parks, athietic courts/fields, dog parks, lake recreation areas, beaches and all areas which are open to public use for recreational, cultural, and community service activities whose primary purpose is to provide group activities to children. is to provide group activities for children.

D. "Child care center(s)": For purposes of this ordinance, child care center(s) means any facility licensed by the State of California, Department of Social Services that provides non-medical care to children in need of personal services, supervision, or as-sistance essential for sustaining the activities of daily living or for the protection of the individual on less than twenty-four (24) hour basis, including, but not limited to, a family day care home, infant center, pre-school, extended day care facility, or school-age child care center

Further, a child care center is defined to include, but not be limited to: any child care or day care services, or children's swimming pools located at an athletic club or facility

E. "School(s)": For purposes of this ordinance, school means the buildings, grounds, and parking lots of any public or private school used for the education of children in kindergarten or in grades 1-12,

Prohibitione and Exemptions A. Any person who is a registered sex offender prohibited from being on or within three hundn (300) feet of the grounds of any park, school, scho bus stop, child care center or library. For purpos of this section, distances shall be measured from ti edge of the parcel or contiguous parcels where till identified use is located. identified use is located.
