

## FOURTH AMENDMENT

This Fourth Amendment ("Amendment") is entered into as of \_\_\_\_\_, 2007, by and between Public Communications Services, Inc. ("PCS"), and the County of El Dorado (formerly with El Dorado County's Sheriff's Office) as ("Client") with respect to the following facts and circumstances:

### Recitals:

A. PCS and Client entered into that certain Inmate Phone Management Agreement dated as of May 15, 2003, and Amendments No. 1, 2 and 3 thereto (as amended, "Agreement").

B. PCS and Client now desire to further amend the Agreement.

C. Modify Original Recitals to remove paragraph #3 regarding the Inmate Welfare Fund Committee. There is no such committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency which are hereby acknowledged, PCS and Client hereby agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:


1. The term of the Agreement is extended to May 15, 2013.

2. Except as expressly modified hereby, the Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect. The parties hereto hereby ratify the Agreement as modified by this Amendment.


