MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING #801-PHD1008
(EDC #438-00190)
AMENDMENT III

This Amendment III to that Agreement for Services #801-PHD1008, made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as County) and Marshall Medical Center, a California non-profit general acute care hospital, duly qualified as a tax exempt organization under Title 26 Code of Federal Regulations Section 1.501 (c) (3) commonly referred to as Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, whose principal place of business is 1100 Marshall Way, Placerville, CA 95667 (hereinafter referred to as Contractor).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Contractor has been designated a Level III Trauma Center, in accordance with MOU #801-PHD1008, dated July 28, 2009, Amendment I, dated July 26, 2011, and Amendment II dated May 1, 2012, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, Contractor received formal notification from the American College of Surgeons (ACS) on April 30, 2012, that it has been approved as a Level III trauma center for the period of May 3, 2011 through May 3, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said notification is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit B - Amended; and

WHEREAS, County has elected to extend the term of this MOU to May 3, 2014, to match Contractor's Level III trauma designation period; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have mutually agreed to amend ARTICLE III – Term.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree that Agreement for Services #801-PHD1008 shall be amended a Third time as follows:

Article III. Term

This Trauma Designation MOU shall be effective when signed by both parties hereto and shall remain in effect from July 28, 2009 through May 3, 2014, unless earlier terminated pursuant to the Article entitled "Default, Termination and Cancellation."

Article III

Term: This Trauma Designation MOU shall be effective when signed by both parties hereto and shall remain in effect from July 28, 2009 through May 3, 2014, unless earlier terminated pursuant to the Article entitled "Default, Termination and Cancellation."

Article XXVI

No Third Party Beneficiaries: Nothing in this Agreement is intended, nor will be deemed, to confer rights or remedies upon any person or legal entity not a party to this Agreement.

Except as herein amended, all other parts and sections of that Agreement #801-PHD1008 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


