**Resolution for Road Closure for the 2016
“Parade of Lights”**

WHEREAS, The Georgetown Divide Rotary (Sponsor) desires to hold the “Parade of Lights” in Georgetown on Saturday, December 3, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said Sponsor has requested for a road closure “Special Event Permit” pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Parade of Lights” on Saturday, December 3, 2016; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Main Street in Georgetown between Harkness Street to State Highway 193 and Harkness Street from B Street to Main Street. Additionally, road barricades will be located at the intersections of Main Street/Placer Street and Main Street/Orleans Street between the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 3, 2016, subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979.


This Resolution and the “Special Event Permit Application” with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the road closure “Special Event Permit”.
