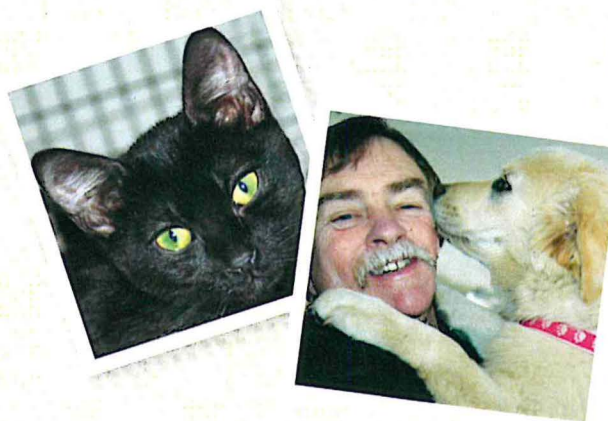

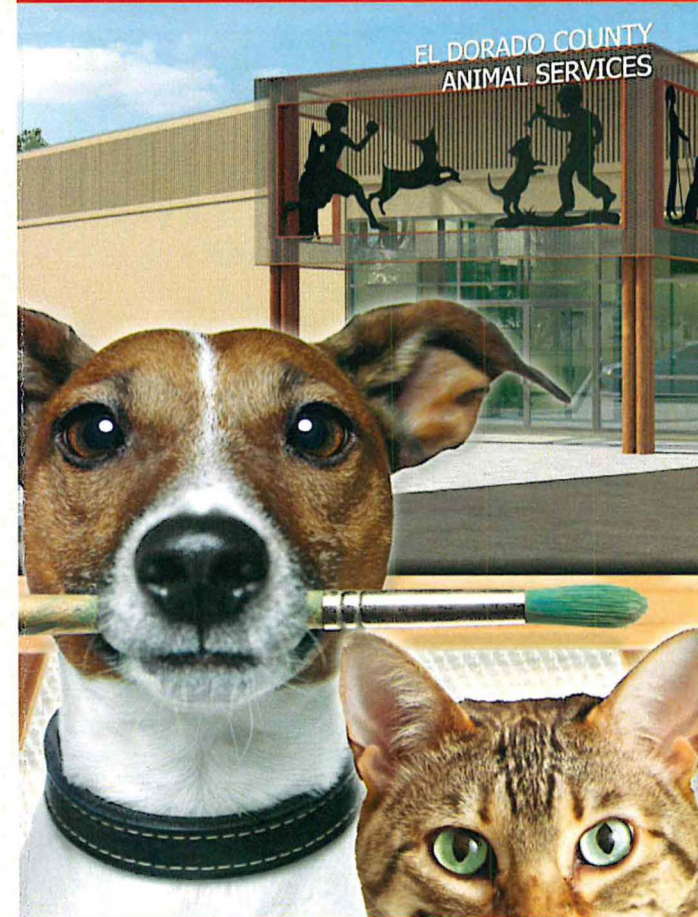

Finishing Touches — Happy Endings!

El Dorado County's new Animal Services Facility—the first permanent shelter on the Western Slope—is under construction and scheduled to open in late 2014. While County funds will complete the project, PAWED's goal is to fund a few specialty equipment items and key features.

As a community, we are about to realize a long-standing objective: a healthy, inviting, modern animal shelter, designed to meet proven care standards and maximize successful adoptions.

Help us put the finishing touches on this exceptional community resource. Join us in making a meaningful and lasting impact on the lives of shelter animals, now and for years to come.

Donor Tile Program—“buy a tile” featuring a digital photo of your pet to be permanently installed in mural format in the adoption area of the new facility. Donation level: \$200 (contact PAWED for more information)

All gifts are important and will receive recognition. You can fund all or part of an item. Contributions of \$1,000 or more will be recorded on a plaque placed in a public viewing area of the new facility (unless donor wishes to remain anonymous). Examples of “finishing touches” and their estimated costs include:

- **Outdoor exercise areas** with synthetic turf and shade structures (\$70,000)
- **Large-animal barn** (\$55,000)
- **Medical equipment** (\$35,000)
- **Cat condos and “towers”** (\$38,000)
- **Grooming equipment** (\$3,500)
