

Public Records Act Request 04 30 13

In the matter of the "Statement" by Chairman Briggs regarding "allegations of conversion of public money to personal use by Dist. II. Supervisor Ray Nutting,"

I am requesting documentation that supports Mr. Brigg's authority to make such a statement without full Board approval. If he can act unilaterally, then I would like a statement from Counsel that he may.

If Mr. Briggs called an emergency meeting to discuss this situation and his proposed action (the statement) then I would like the minutes from that meeting and support that it was properly noticed.

Is it true that every member of the Board was unaware of the investigation until KOVR's news segment (as the Statement indicates)? If so, then I would like a document stating that each member was unaware.

The reason I'm bringing up these questions is I am concerned about correct procedure being followed. It appears that the Board and some of the Commission and Committees may need to attend a refresher course on The Brown Act.
