

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered into as of March 1, 2015, by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of El Dorado Division of Behavioral Health Plan (hereinafter referred to as "County MHP") and KP Cal, LLC (hereinafter referred to as "KAISER") in order to implement certain provisions of CCR, Title 9, Section 1810.370, Welfare and Institutions Code 14715 and other applicable law. The term of this MOU shall not exceed three (3) years. This MOU may be terminated by either party by giving at least 10 days written notice to the other party.

KAISER has contracted with the California Department of Health Care Services ("DHCS"), pursuant to its Geographic Managed Care ("GMC") Medi-Cal contract that includes El Dorado County, to arrange and coordinate the provision of Medi-Cal managed care services to those Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are assigned to or enrolled with KAISER in the Service Area.

Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) for Medi-Cal beneficiaries who reside in El Dorado County are the responsibility of County MHP. County MHP contracts with the DHCS to provide medically necessary Specialty Mental Health Services to the Medi-Cal beneficiaries of El Dorado County. The County MHP, DHCS and KAISER work collaboratively to ensure timely and effective access to Medi-Cal Mental Health Services.

The purpose of this MOU is to comply with the requirements of DHCS All Plan Letter (APL) 13-018. This MOU describes the responsibilities of the County MHP in the delivery of Specialty Mental Health Services and KAISER's responsibilities to provide outpatient mental health services to KAISER Members served by both parties. It is the intention of the parties to coordinate care between providers of physical and mental health care. All references in the MOU to "Members" are limited to the KAISER Members. There will be no exchange of funds between KAISER and the County MHP.
