OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO
Recognizing Marshall Medical Center for the 2021 Top Hospital Award

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center was named a Top General Hospital nationally by The Leapfrog Group. This award is widely acknowledged as one of the most competitive awards American hospitals can receive; and

WHEREAS, The Leapfrog Group is a national nonprofit organization driving a movement for giant leaps forward in the quality and safety of American health care; and

WHEREAS, the Top Hospital designation is recognized as the toughest standard-setter for healthcare safety, quality and patient care across many areas of hospital performance and is considered in establishing the qualifications for the award; and

WHEREAS, The Leapfrog Group recently released Hospital Safety Grades for nearly 3,000 hospitals nationwide, giving Marshall an “A”. This grade is based on how well a hospital prevents medical errors, accidents, injuries, and infections that kill or harm patients which reflects the performance on more than 30 evidence-based measures; and

WHEREAS, the President and CEO of the Leapfrog Group stated, “Even with the continued strain of the COVID-19 pandemic, Marshall has demonstrated an extraordinary dedication to excellent health care in El Dorado County. We congratulate the board, leadership, staff and clinicians who put their patients first”; and

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has been the face of healthcare in El Dorado County. The Center includes Marshall Hospital, a fully accredited acute care facility with 111 beds in Placerville; several outpatient facilities in Cameron Park, El Dorado Hills and Georgetown; and many community health and education programs. Marshall has over 220 licensed practitioners and over 1,400 employees providing quality healthcare services to our communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors does wish to congratulate Marshall Medical Center on receiving the Leapfrog award that recognizes how diligent staff, practitioners and management are to the citizens and patients of El Dorado County.
