



RESOLUTION NO. 127-2022

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 was enacted by the legislature in 1997 and empowered your Board of Supervisors to direct the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to collect a \$1 fee per vehicle that can be expended exclusively to fund programs that enhance the capacity of local law enforcement to provide automated mobile and fixed location fingerprint identification of individuals who may be involved in driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or vehicular manslaughter or any combination of those and other vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 1997, Resolution 270-97 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 imposing the collection of an additional \$1 fee on motor vehicles registration fee and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2013, the Board of Supervisors suspended the collection of this fee due to a surplus in the account and

WHEREAS, on April 19, 2016, the Board re-instated the collection of this \$1 vehicle registration fee for automated fingerprint services by rescinding Resolution 010-2013.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors suspends the collection of this fee due to a surplus in the account and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors gives authority to Sheriff and Auditor-Controller to execute any further documents required by the DMV to suspend the collection of this \$1 fee.


