



Proclamation
by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors
Proclaiming October 6, 2012 to be
Take A Kid Mountain Biking Day

WHEREAS, *The County has a 25 mile long natural trail from the Western County line to Missouri Flat Road in Diamond Springs that is used by mountain bikers as well as others; and*

WHEREAS, *The County Museum has a Living History Train Program adjacent to the El Dorado Trail in the Town of EL Dorado that teaches and demonstrates the County's railroad history; and*

WHEREAS, *It is desirable to have kids outside engaging in physical exercise and learning about the County's railroad history; and*

WHEREAS, *The County finds it desirable to inform both local and regional populations of these two County assets; and*

WHEREAS, *Take a Kid Mountain Biking Day is an international event developed and coordinated by IMBA (International Mountain Bicycling Association) with a special emphasis this year to reach out to families of our nation's military; and*

WHEREAS, *The El Dorado Western Railroad Foundation members working as volunteers for the County Museum and Friends of the EL Dorado Trail volunteers jointly will advertise and facilitate the public's participation in this event;*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, *that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado does herewith proclaim October 6, 2012 to be **Take a Kid Mountain Biking Day** and encourages county and city residents to ride the El Dorado Trail and participate in the County Museum's Living History Train Program.*
