How did we get here?



- ❧ Previous Department Needs for County Roadway Closures
- ❧ December 30, 2022 - Closure / Atmospheric River
- ❧ Community questioned closure
- ❧ January 10, 2023 - BOS declared a State of Emergency, closed the Rubicon Trail & directed staff to come back with a new resolution.

Community Input



- ❧ February 13, 2023 – County & Stakeholder’s Meeting
- ❧ Discussion regarding Resolution 015-2013
- ❧ March 6, 2023 – Draft Resolution sent to Stakeholders.
- ❧ Comments were encouraged, due on March 13, 2023, at 12:00 pm.
- ❧ Six comments were received

Comments Received

- ❧ Any closure should be communicated better and should be at the direction of DOT Director
- ❧ Remove Rubicon from this Resolution and revert back to 015-2013
- ❧ Any closure of the Rubicon Trail puts RS2477 at risk
- ❧ Limit closures to 7-days
- ❧ Closure should only be for the following reasons:
 - ❧ Pursuant to Attachment C
 - ❧ Interest of public safety
 - ❧ Declared state of emergency
- ❧ Remove Sunset Date

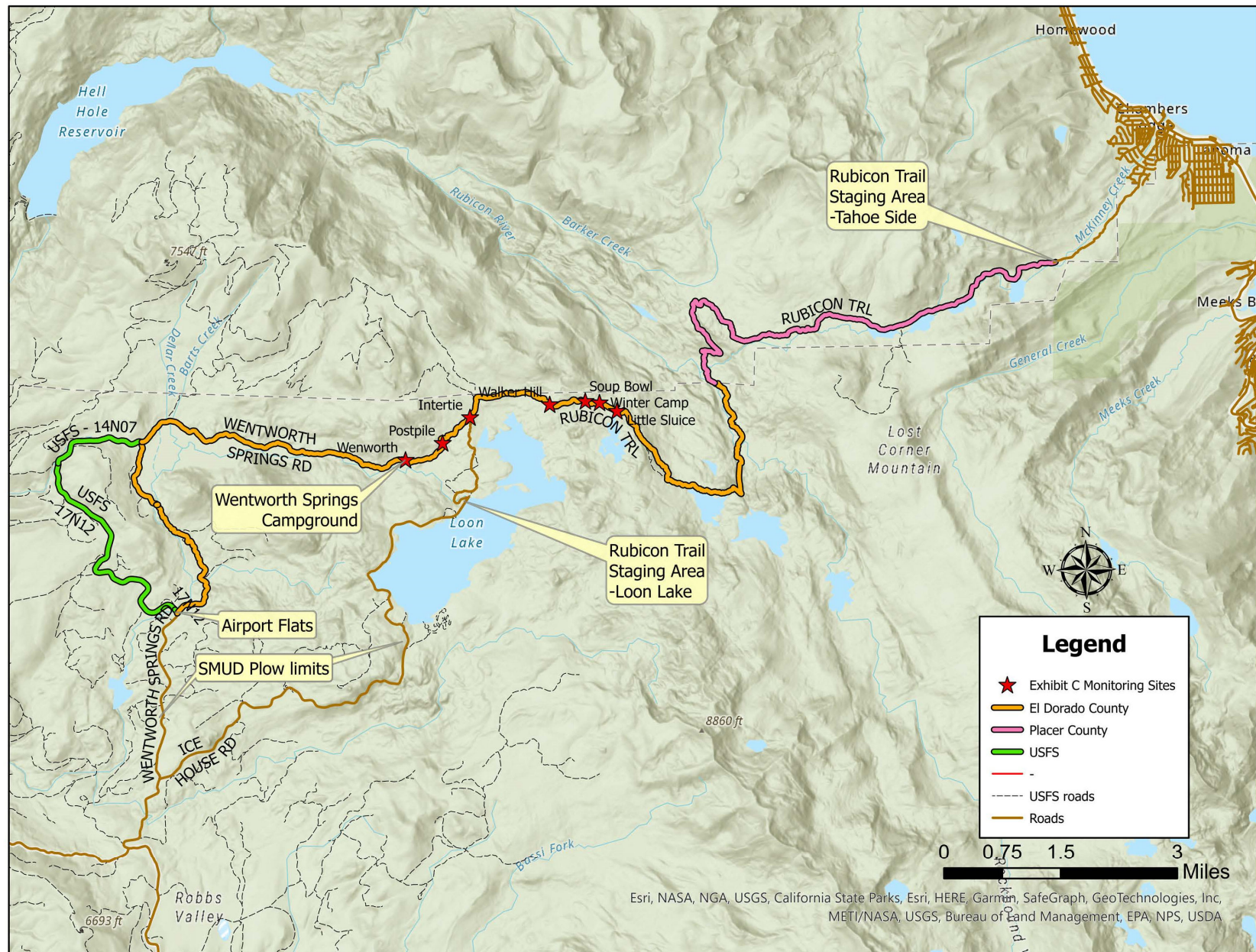
