The Environmental Management Department recommends that your Board: 1) award Bid #005-PW-06/07-11, Bid Schedule, Option 2 for the Final Cover 13.6-Acre Class III Old Landfill Area at the Union Mine Disposal Site to the lowest responsive, responsible, and qualified bidder, Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,862,600, for a period of 60 calendar days and 2) authorize the Chairman to execute the Contract upon final approval of the insurance, payment and performance bonds by County Counsel and Risk Management. A copy of the "Request for Bids" process and supporting documents can be viewed at the Environmental Management Department located at 2850 Fairlane Ct., Placerville, CA. (Funding - Non-General Fund)

#### ☐ Reasons for Recommendations:

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R5-2006-0020 for the Union Mine Landfill was adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, at its January 26, 2006, meeting. In accordance with the WDRs, closure of the remaining 15.8-acre unclosed area of the Class III Landfill Area has to be completed by October 15, 2006. As part of the Final Closure Plan, which was submitted to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region on March 30, 2006, it was identified that 13.6 acres of the 15.8-acre Class III Old Landfill Area will receive final cover in the year 2006. The remaining 2.2 acres are schedule to be closed in the year 2040, the projected closure date of the Class II active disposal area.

On July 18, 2006, your Board approved the release of a Request for Bids (RFB) for the Final Cover of 13.6-Acres Class III Old Landfill Area at the Union Mine Disposal Site. The RFB and Bid Documents were mailed to twenty-two potential contractors and placed on the Environmental Management website. The RFB was formally placed in the Mountain Democrat on July 21, 24, 26, 28, 31, and August 4, 7, 11, 2006. The RFB was also placed in the Sacramento Bee on July 21, 23, 28, 30, and August 4, 2006.

Three bid proposals were opened on August 17, 2006 at 2:00 P.M. One bid proposal was deemed non-responsive.
