

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of General Services recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve revised Bid Documents for Georgetown Airport, Security Fencing and Gates, AIP Project # 03-06-0093-06, Bid # 07-968-091, and authorize Chairman to execute same; and
2. Authorize the Department of General Services to advertise project with Bids due no later than 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 13, 2007.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION:

This project was previously authorized and bids were received on September 21, 2006. The bid received from the lowest qualified bidder was \$291,300.00, or 187% greater than the engineers' estimate of \$155,600. As a result, the available grant funding was insufficient to move forward with construction, and a decision was made to reject all bids. Since that time, the scope of work associated with the project has been changed, and the requirement to clear the fence line of brush prior to construction has been eliminated (that service is now being provided via a separate contract).

The project is required to secure and protect the runway and operations area of the Georgetown Airport to protect unauthorized access to the Airport runway. The FAA originally approved the grant funding under AIP # 03-06-0093-06 in August 2004.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The requested action of approving the project for bid has no fiscal impact.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN FOLLOWING APPROVAL:

General Services will advertise, with bids due no later than 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 13, 2007, and will return to the Board, for anticipated award of bid on Tuesday, March 13, 2007.
