OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR CONTROLLER TO TRANSFER
UNCLAIMED STALE DATED WARRANTS UNDER \$15 TO THE COUNTY GENERAL
FUND UNDER PROVISION OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION §50055

WHEREAS, Government Code §50055 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to transfer to the general fund any individual items of less than fifteen dollars (\$15), or any amount if the depositor's name is unknown, which remain unclaimed in the treasury or in the official custody of an officer of a local agency for the period of one year or upon an order of the court without the necessity of publication of a notice in a newspaper.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code § 50055, stale dated warrants that remain unclaimed in excess of the specified period may be transferred to the general fund of the county by the county auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, State of California, find and declare that \$5,262.33 of warrants exist, as reported to this Board by the County Auditor-Controller as Exhibit "B" and incorporated into this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board directs the County Auditor-Controller to transfer these warrants that remained unclaimed for one year or more to the County general fund in accordance with Government Code §50055.
