**RESOLUTION NO. 028-2009**

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, the County of El Dorado is facing serious economic hardships, and

**WHEREAS**, in response to these constraints, there is an ongoing critical need to reduce expenditures and improve the County's cash position; and

**WHEREAS**, a temporary office closure is a viable method for conserving cash and achieving savings; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the County's best interest to support and encourage such a program when practicable and allowed by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby directs that County offices, with exceptions noted below, shall be closed to the public on the following dates:

Friday, February 13, 2009  
Friday, March 13, 2009  
Friday, April 10, 2009  
Friday, May 8, 2009  
Friday, June 19, 2009

The following offices shall be exempt from the public closure: Placerville and South Lake Tahoe Jails, Placerville and South Lake Tahoe Probation Offices, South Lake Tahoe Juvenile Treatment Center, Placerville Juvenile Hall, Sheriff Records office, Placerville Recorder's Office, Psychiatric Health Facility, and all Library branches.

The Treasurer/Tax Collector's Office shall be closed on all of the dates above, excluding April 10, 2009.
