I respectfully request that Item # 21-0511 be pulled from the Consent Calendar. Some of my concerns are as follows:

1. There is much controversy over the PCR tests and the practices the labs use, manipulating test results by changing Cycle Thresholds. The more Cycle Thresholds the more likely to get a false positive. Please see the below article where CDC has changed the recommended Cycle Thresholds to just 20 for the vaccinated. Meanwhile the unvaccinated will likely stay around the 40 range. This is manipulative testing practices!!!

2. If there is to be a contract with any lab there needs to be a requirement for the Labs to report the Cycle Threshold used just as the State of Florida requires.

3. Even if this money is coming from State or Federal funds this money is still our tax dollars and \$3.15 million could be better spent elsewhere.

4. A lot has changed since 2020. Covid 19 has proven to be greatly survivable for almost all risk categories. Anyone that wants a vaccine is able to get one and there are alternative treatments for those that chose not to be vaccinated.
