DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Construction of Angora Creek improvements downstream of View Circle including but not limited to dewatering, tree removal, inset floodplain grading and biotechnical stabilization in the existing creek channel, and irrigation. Completion of the Angora Creek improvements upstream of View Circle including, but not limited to, tie-in of the new channel to existing, channel rewatering, dewatering and filling and restoring the existing channel (gully), culvert removal and road replacement at View Circle, removal of south spoil pile, revegetation and irrigation.		
LOCATION OF PROJECT: In the Tahoe Basin in El Dorado County, west of U.S. Highway 50, near Meyers. The project site is roughly bounded by Lake Tahoe Blvd. to the west and Washoe Meadows State Park to the east and is approximately 1.5 miles upstream of the confluence of Angora Creek with the Upper Truckee River.


**DEFINITION OF COMPLETION OF THE WORK**

**In accordance with Section 10-1.26 "Landscape Maintenance" of the Special Provisions, Contractor shall perform plant establishment work for one season beginning on or about June 1, 2008 and ending on or about September 30, 2008, or when conditions no longer require continued irrigation of the revegetated areas, whichever is later.**
