

RESOLUTION NO. 054-2015

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Resolution to Authorize the Director of Transportation to Temporarily Close a Section of Black Bart Avenue During a Portion of the 2015 Construction Season

WHEREAS, El Dorado County plans to construct Capital Improvement Program Project No. 72188, the Black Bart Avenue, Barbara Avenue, and Martin Avenue Overlay Project in South Lake Tahoe, during the 2015 construction season; and,

WHEREAS, the existing pavement on Barbara Avenue will be cold planed and replaced with new asphalt concrete pavement as part of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, in order to place the new asphalt concrete pavement, Black Bart Avenue, between Pioneer Trail to the intersection at Jack Bell Court, will need to be closed for no more than one (1) continuous week; and,

WHEREAS, alternate access routes are available during the temporary closure and traffic will be directed by signage to these routes; and,

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code, Section 21101, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to temporarily close a portion of any street for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Sections 942.5 and 942.6, the Board of Supervisors may designate the Director of Transportation to determine the exact dates and times for the closure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Transportation is authorized to order the temporary closure of Black Bart Avenue, between Pioneer Trail to the intersection at Jack Bell Court, for no more than one (1) continuous week during the time period from June 9, 2015 to July 7, 2015 for the placement of asphalt concrete pavement and related activities. The precise dates of the temporary road closure are to be determined by the Director of Transportation, with notification of the pending temporary road closure and alternate access routes to be provided to the County Supervisor of District 5, general public, and to safety and law enforcement agencies in the Project area, through notice in local media.
