## A. The good/service requested is restricted to one supplier for the reason stated below:

1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this goods/services supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively sourced. Explain how the supplier is the only source for the acquisition.)

4Sight Labs Inc. is the sole designer, manufacturer, training provider, and authorized seller of the Overwatch system. The lack of resellers precludes competitive bidding.

2. Provide the background of events leading to this acquisition.

Sheriff Custody have considered improvements in the area of health monitoring of its residents for some time. Problems that have been grappled are: lack of health monitoring for residents in real time, limited availability of modular, wireless monitoring that can withstand conditions in a custody facility (jail), and that can provide health data that can be acted upon.

3. Describe the uniqueness of the acquisition. (Why was the goods/services supplier chosen?)

To the best of the Sheriff's knowledge, no other modular, wireless, mobile platform offers real-time health monitoring at this scale with minimal hardware installation, relying solely on plug-and-play devices. Its capabilities are further secured by provisional patents and proprietary software and hardware, underscoring its exclusivity. It is expected to provide exceptional durability, impact resistance, and waterproof capabilities, with sensors worn on wrists and ankles using hypoallergenic bands, which are both reusable and disposable. Custody personnel will be allowed to continuously monitor critical vital signs such as heart rate, oxygen saturation, and skin temperature. This can move health monitoring from reactive to more proactive with the residents.

4. What are the consequences of not purchasing the goods/services or contracting with the proposed supplier?

The consequences of not purchasing Overwatch could lead residents to suffer from delayed responses to medical emergencies. Current health monitoring solutions do not adequately enable proactive interventions based on biometric data, resulting in missed opportunities to prevent medical emergencies and improve health outcomes. Further limits with other health monitoring systems fail to integrate biometric sensors, wireless connectivity, and cloud analytics effectively, limiting their ability to provide comprehensive and actionable health data. So to is the lack of durability to withstand jail conditions and the comfort required for continuous wear, reducing their effectiveness and resident compliance.

Market research and suitable alternatives for this purchase are scarce. The BioSticker system from BioIntelliSense was the only one applicable to a custody facility. Cloud-based maintenance and support were not available in a one time purchase. VitalConnect, Masimo, and Philips health monitoring systems are more tailored to healthcare facilities, and were not pursued.
