A. The good/service requested is restricted to one supplier for the reason stated below:

1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this goods/services supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively sourced. Explain how the supplier is the only source for the acquisition.)

El Dorado County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) contracts with as many qualified vendors as possible to provide the highest level of psychiatric care to Medi-Cal beneficiaries residing in El Dorado County. This includes Institutes for Mental Disease and MHRCs. Because the need for these services far outweighs the availability of beds, qualified vendors are not anticipated to respond to any competitive solicitation released by HHSA. Additionally, HHSA seeks to maintain contracts due to client/clinician continuity of care.

2. Provide the background of events leading to this acquisition.

On behalf of the County, the HHSA contracts with the State as the Medi-Cal Mental Health Plan (MHP). As the MHP, HHSA is required to provide Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) to eligible individuals, including long-term residential facility placements when appropriate. To meet this requirement, the MHP contracts with providers of MHRC facilities to ensure availability of services on an "as requested" basis in accordance with Title 9 and Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations and Division 5, Chapter 5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code.

3. Describe the uniqueness of the acquisition. (Why was the goods/services supplier chosen?)

Canyon Manor is licensed by the State of California to provide MHRC services to adults with SMI and operates an 89-bed facility in Marin County. Because specialty skills not expressly identified in County classifications are required for the performance of this work, and the County does not have the staff or facilities to provide residential treatment services for BHD clients, HHSA has been contracting with Canyon Manor since 2016.

4. What are the consequences of not purchasing the goods/services or contracting with the proposed supplier?

If HHSA did not contract with this vendor, BHD would continue to provide residential SMHS through existing contracts, but would be limited in its access to these types of facilities. Subsequently, the County would have diminished capacity to provide services required of the MHP. Additionally, the continuity of care for BHD Clients currently placed in at Canyon Manor would be disrupted.

5. What market research was conducted to substantiate no competition, including the evaluation of other items or service providers? HHSA seeks to contract with all qualified residential SMHS providers to ensure it has the capacity to meet its obligations as the MHP.
B. Price Analysis:

Because this service is an entitlement for Medi-Cal beneficiaries, cost analysis has not been completed. This is due to the MHP's need to have residential treatment facilities available for the timely placement of eligible clients.

At the time of client placement, proximity to El Dorado County as well as daily rates may be considered if multiple vendors have available beds.
